Lost Whippet!

It is a terrible thing if your dog goes missing. I lost a dog many years ago. Not knowing what happened was awful. It took me 10 years to get over the loss - when I knew he would be gone anyway. Be prepared!

- 1. Use a safe collar with phone numbers.
- 2. Get a microchip and check that it works every time you go to the vet.
- 3. Never let the dog lose in unfamiliar territory.
- 4. Be sure you have a good picture of the Whippet to use for flyers in case it is missing.
