An International Whippet:

Australian and American Champion Byerley Savile Row ROMX

It is important to keep the Whippet International; to make sure the gene pool stays large, and that the Whippets do not develop into small local breeds without a future. This is why "Sav" was so important. Sav is behind our Tangens litters 2005, 2009, 2011, and 2017.

Here is what happened: Iva Kimmelman Merci Isle Whippets, was judging in Australia when she saw Sav and fell in love with him. He was then four years old and an Australian Champion. Iva tried to buy him, but his owners, Peter Moore and Peter Griffiths, didn't want to sell him. After some negotiations they allowed Iva to lease him for a year and a half.



In 2004 Iva flew from Boston to San Diego to pick up Sav from his flight from Melbourne to LAX ("only" 17 hours). I drove Iva to LAX. I will never forget Sav's looks when he got out of his crate; anxious and confused as he first stepped onto the US soil. Iva took the picture where I tried to comfort him. We thought he needed to pee after the long flight, but apparently not at LAX, so we stopped at a beach park. Still no peeing. We continued to Alpine where Iva and Sav were going to stay with Rachel Amado until they flew to Boston.



During his 1 ½ years in the US Sav sired 12 litters. Our 2005 litter was his first. Iva had him "collected" while with her and had a litter from him in 2017 – 4 years after his death! ROMX after Sav's name means that at least 25 of his offspring became US champions in conformation, racing or lure coursing.
