Joey is an absolute fiend when it comes to food. He will eat any food, any time, with no questions asked. Needless to say, sometimes the family will feed him at work. Somehow, without intentionally doing so, my brother and father taught Joey to "sing and dance" when they had some food that he wanted. I've included a video of the process.

Joev is a very good dog and we are very happy with him. His favorite things in the word, in order of priority are: 1) food 2) food 3) running/sleeping. If we fed him a quarter of the amount he wanted to eat he would probably weigh 100 pounds. He has figured out how to unzip the zipper on my lunch box with his nose/mouth. 
