In Sweden, the most common question is: "Do they race?" People know about Greyhounds racing for fun or competition — but they don't know anything about Greyhound rescues, as there is no commercial Greyhound racing here, and therefor no Greyhounds to rescue.


Another comment" "A lot of dogs!" My answer: "Only five"

The Nordic countries, including Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Finland and Iceland, registered about 1500 Whippets last year.


Compare that to the 1600 Whippets registered by AKC in the US, with a ten times larger human population.


