A dog of my breeding had a tumor, and the final bill of removing it and getting all the pathology done was over \$5.000. Another swallowed something that didn't get up or down and required a \$5,000 surgery to take out. I read that an Italian Greyhound breeder no longer sells a puppy unless the owner promises to get a health insurance for the puppy. IGs have a tendency to break their legs as youngsters, and this breeder had had to take back a dog with broken legs on more than one occasion, because the new owner could not pay the vet bills.
